POLICIES FOR USE OF SOUTHBOROUGH TOWN FIELDS.

- Groups are responsible for bringing their own trash bags and placing any trash in the dumpster.
- Wash tables after use
- Please post permit on the entrance to the pavilion during use
- A group with a permit has priority over a group without a permit
- Reservations are a first come, first serve basis. No phone reservations are accepted.
- Please call in to cancel your original requested date if you would like to schedule a rain date. There will be a \$15 charge for every request change after that.
- Balloons must be removed from the pavilion at end of use. Any broken balloon pieces should also be picked up.
- Alcoholic beverages are not permitted at Recreation facilties.
- Charcoal and gas grills and other fires are not permitted.
- The applicant must receive adequate supervision for the event.

Event organizers must comply with all laws, rules, and regulations regarding use of the Town's outdoor recreation facilities. Groups that violate laws of Recreation Department regulations, or use facilities without authorization, may be denied future use of the Town's outdoor recreation facilities or may be subject to fines or other legal action.
